Harrison Hall History

In 1951, as a gift to his wife, G. Hale began construction on the Harrison Hall Hotel, originally a 77 room property facing the Atlantic on 15th Street. It would be the most lavish hotel of its kind for the day. Then, the northernmost property in town, it was also the first hotel to provide private bathrooms for each



guest room.

The idea of having a competitive advantage was deeply embedded into Lois' two sons. In 1961 G. Hale passed leaving Lois in charge of Harrison Hall. The daily operation of the hotel became a lifestyle for the family.
